



RE: Changes to your RCCO contract and your Per Member Per Month (PMPM) payments

Dear Provider:

We are excited to announce that Colorado Access has been awarded the Regional Accountable Entity (RAE) contracts for Region 3 (Adams, Arapahoe, Douglas, and Elbert counties), and Region 5 (City and County of Denver). The RAEs will replace the Regional Care Collaborative Organizations (RCCOs), effective July 1, 2018. At that time, the responsibility for payment of the PMPM will transition from the State to each RAE.

You are receiving this letter because you are or will be a contracted provider for one of the Colorado Access RAE regions - Region 3 or Region 5. All existing RCCO agreements will expire on June 30, 2018 and be replaced by the new Professional Provider Agreements. As a part of this change, the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) requires that all RCCO primary care medical providers (PCMPs) enter into new Value Based Payment Agreements with their respective RAEs.

You will be receiving a new Professional Provider Agreement from us early in the first quarter of 2018, by encrypted email. That email will provide you with an eSignature option through DocuSign. We are pleased to have this new capability, and hope that it will ensure a smooth transition into the new Professional Provider Agreements. Detailed instructions will be included with the new contract.

We appreciate your cooperation while we prepare to recontract after the first of the year will follow up soon with additional details.
