Behavioral health

You may have heard the terms behavioral health or mental health. They mean different things. Behavioral health looks at how your behavior affects your health and well-being. Mental health is your emotional and social well-being. So, the two terms are linked, but they are not the same.

Mental health affects how your child thinks, feels, and acts. Mental health conditions are things like depression, anxiety, and bipolar disorder. Some of these are caused by genetics. Others are caused by behavioral health needs.

Behavioral health focuses on the link between your child's behaviors and their health and well-being. This means things like eating habits or exercise routines. Behavioral health conditions are things like substance use disorder or eating disorders. They are caused by certain behaviors.

If your child's mental or behavioral health has a strong impact on their daily life and their ability to relate to others, they might have a mental or behavioral health condition. Some common signs are things like lasting sadness, avoiding social interactions, changes in eating habits, or trouble sleeping.

If you notice signs like these that last more than two weeks in your child, call their doctor. You can also talk to a therapist. Or call a community mental health office or crisis center. If your child is diagnosed with a mental or behavioral health condition, there are many treatment choices. Therapy or medication are common treatment options. Work with their doctor to find the best

option for your child.
