Integrated behavioral health changes

SHORT-TERM BEHAVIORAL HEALTH BENEFIT


The Short-Term Behavioral Health Benefit (STBHB) allowed providers to bill the Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) for up to six short-term behavioral health and substance use disorder visits for Medicaid members in primary care settings, supporting the delivery of integrated care

WHAT IS HAPPENING

- HCPF replacing STBHB with a more comprehensive integrated care benefit
- Standard psychotherapy services still covered by Medicaid
- Effective July 1, 2025, psychotherapy services must be billed to the member's Regional Accountable Entity (RAE)
- Providers must contract with Colorado Access to bill for behavioral health services
 - Two options:
 - Establish a new contract with behavioral health component
 - Modify existing Colorado Access contract to include behavioral health services

Billing opportunities

- Expanded billing code options
 - Providers can bill any codes listed in the billing manual, <u>as applicable</u>
 - Access HCPF's billing manual here: https://hcpf.colorado.gov/sbhs-billing-manual
 - Refer to Appendix I (pages 143-151) in the billing manual for additional details about billing for members 21 years old and younger
 - Ensure that the specific billing codes you intend to use are clearly detailed in your contract, allowing you to bill for those codes
 - Billing most behavioral health services requires a behavioral health diagnosis
 - Some exceptions exist, for more detailed information, see

Diagnosis details and exceptions

- **General Exception:** Codes **90791** and **90792** do **not** ever require a covered diagnosis
- Carve-Out for Members Under 21 with a Non-Covered Diagnosis (NCD):
 - As of January 1, 2024, Autism Spectrum Disorder (F84.0-F84.9) is a covered diagnosis for psychotherapy services (90785, 90791, 90792, 90832-90838, 90846-90849, 90853)
 - These members must have a diagnosis, but it can be autism (typically an NCD)
 - More information can be found in the Covered Diagnosis section: https://hcpf.colorado.gov/bh-policies
- SB23-174 Coverage Policy allows for **symptomology or SDOH codes** to be used **for 18 BH services** when provided to **members under 21**

Member completes a screener



Primary Care Provider discusses results



Member describes symptoms of anxiety



BH provider assesses member for symptoms, and determines next steps
