- H0006
 - To simplify billing, HCPF will sunset this code as of **December 31, 2025**. Claims for H0006 with dates of service on or after **January 1, 2026**, will deny. All behavioral health targeted case management services must be billed under **T1017 (Behavioral Health Targeted Case Management)** instead.
 - Providers contracted with a RAE to deliver T1017 may transition immediately.
 - Prior to the sunset date, HCPF will not enforce the NCCI edit for H0006 and will align it with the **Colorado MUE limit of 4 units per day (1 unit = 15 minutes/day)** for T1017.
